

# From the Pastor ~~

Matthew 8:23-27

During His time on earth, Jesus demonstrated how to have a healthy relationship with God. Everything our Savior did flowed from a life of restful dependence on His Father-even when resting seemed foolish and negligent to those around Him. In today's passage, the disciples were crossing the sea in a small boat during a violent storm, and Jesus was taking a nap. They may have wondered, Why is He sleeping at a time like this? Doesn't He see our need? It seems the disciples viewed Jesus' resting as a sign of inattentiveness. But the truth is, God sometimes delays responding to our fears to better display His glory at work in our life. A moment later, Jesus commanded the waves and wind to be calm

and the disciples witnessed firsthand the power of God. They asked themselves who is this man who the wind and the waves obey. Jesus' shows ability to surrender, complete trust in His Father something the disciples were also invited to experience. The invitation holds true for us as well. Instead of trusting the disciples were afraid. Why fear when the Creator of the universe is on our side? In times of hardship and testing, it's easy to be consumed by the physical reality of our situation. But let's not lose sight of the truth that God is with us. Always.

Good Shepherd Church Council met on June 9, 2024 after our worship service. Those in attendance were: Brian Walker, Michelle Walker, Larry Hill, Kevin Weber, Heidi Baca, Amy Houck, Gerda Martin, Randy Powers, Johannah Pollert and Rose Krimmel. Those absent: Pastor Daene, Troy Johnson and Kent Krimmel.

President Brian Walker asked Kevin Weber to say a prayer.

Johannah, Council Secretary, presented the minutes from our April meeting. After review a motion was made to accept. Motion carried.

Rose, Financial Secretary, presented the April offerings as \$18,262.08 and the May offerings and other income as \$11,840.00.

Larry, Treasurer, presented expenses for April as \$17,601.83 and for May as \$14,224.65.

Pastor Daene was absent—no report.

Kevin Weber-no report.

Troy Johnson was absent—no report. Heidi, Christian Education Chair reported the children are studying the New Testament and Children's Church will be on non-communion Sundays.

Michelle, Missions Chair, reported that we collected 56 pounds of Peanut Butter and canned vegetables in May for the InterChurch Food Pantry.

Gerda and Amy, Fellowship & Special Events reported we did not have a Pitchin during May. LWGS had eight ladies attend Ladies Night Out at Olive Garden. The books for LWGS for 2022-2023 have been reviewed and are in good shape.

Randy, Member-at-Large, reported that he has been unable to sell the stamp collection donated to Good Shepherd or even get any interest in them. The total value of the stamps is \$77.33 assuming all of the stamps are usable. Randy stated he and Elaine would buy the stamps at the postage value. Gerda stated LWML takes stamps and any he cannot use to donate them to LWML.

New Business: Council reviewed the Policy on Loaning out Tables and Chairs from the church. After review, a motion was made to just remove the parts that refers to the tables and chairs in the Garage/Shelter. Approved. The new policy is posted on the bulletin board in the hall-way.
